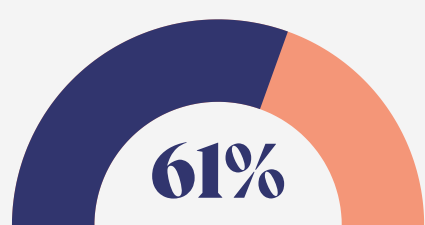
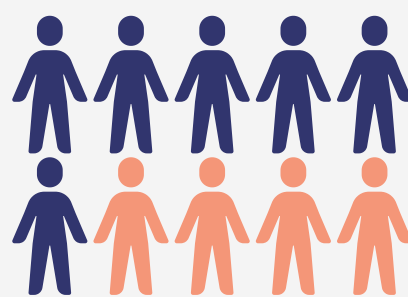


# Understanding homelessness in England

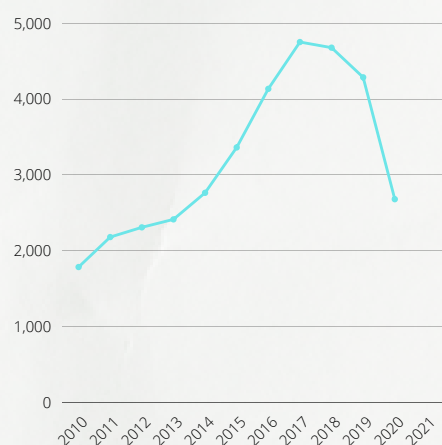
## DATA 1

In 2021, there were 2440 people sleeping rough on a single night in England in autumn

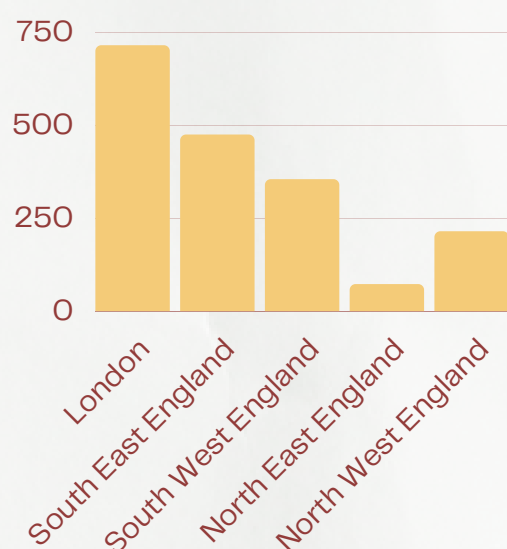


## DATA 2

61% of 2180 adults surveyed support investing money in preventing homelessness rather than paying to deal with the issue when it reaches crisis stage.
